Local Law # 4 of 2017

A local law to amend the Fee Schedule for Special events in the Village of Piermont

Village Code section 102-4 (“Schedule of Fees”) and Chapter 141 (“Parades, Processions and Special events”) shall be amended as follows:

[New language in italics]

§ 102-4 Schedule of fees.

...

I.

Permit fees for Special Events (subject to annual review by the Village Board of Trustees).

(1) Major events:

(a)

\$500 per hour, with a minimum of three hours being charged for each Major Special Event, provided that the application is made no later than 60 days prior to the Major Special Event.

(b)

\$750 per hour, with a minimum of three hours being charged for each Major Special Event, provided that the application is made less than 60 days prior to the Major Special Event.

(2) Low-impact events:

(a) \$250 per hour, with a minimum of three hours being charged for each Low-Impact Special Event.

(b) The total fee can be set at less than \$250 per hour based upon determination of the Chief of Police and DPW Superintendent calculating historic costs associated with similar Low Impact Special Events.

(3)

When considering an application for a special event, the Village Board may, by resolution, cap the fees charged for any special event at the actual cost incurred by the Village, or upon the estimated cost based on historic cost assessment.

Chapter 141 – Parades, processions and Special Events

§ 141-2 Schedule of fees.

...

MAJOR EVENTS

Major Special Events are Special Events that require the closure of any portion of Piermont Avenue or any major thoroughfare, or or multiple thoroughfares for any length of time; or when additional personnel are required to protect the health safety and welfare of residents and visitors of the Village. The determination of additional personnel is at the discretion of the Chief of Police, DPW Superintendent and Board of Trustees.

...

§ 141-7 Issuance of Permit

A. For parades and processions, payment of the required fee of \$250 within five days, not counting holidays of Sundays, after the application is made.

(1) The application fee may be waived for Piermont-based, registered non-profit (501C-3) organizations.

B. For Major Special Events:

(1) NO CHANGE (\$300)

(2) NO CHANGE (\$600)

C. For Low Impact Events, an application fee of \$250, together with the required fee as set forth in Chapter 102 of the Code, within five days, not counting holidays of Sundays, after the application is made.

(1) The application fee may be waived for Piermont-based, registered non-profit (501C-3) organizations.

...

This Local Law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
